## **Active / Passive Voice**

- Active: The children saw the movie subject verb Object
  - Passive: The movie was seen by the children subject verb by + agent
    - Form: The passive is formed with the auxiliary "to be" (in the appropriate tense) + past participle (of the main verb).
      - **Example:** Toyota cars <u>are made</u> in Japan to be + past participle
        - ✓ Passive sentence
    - **The Rule:** The passive voice is formed by using a form of the auxiliary verb "be" (be, am, is, are, was, were, being, been) followed by the past participle of the main verb.

Active	Passive
A committee <b>chooses</b> the winner	The winner <b>is chosen</b> by a committee

TENSE	ACTIVE	PASSIVE
Present Simple	I do my homework.	My homework is done.
Present Continuous	I'm doing my homework.	My homework is being done.
Past Simple	I did my homework.	My homework was done.
Past Continuous	I was doing my homework.	My homework was being done.
Present Perfect	I have done my homework.	My homework has been done.
Past Perfect	I had done my homework.	My homework had been done.
