Word formation

Word formation as "creating new words from existing words," word-formation ranges from prefixation and suffixation (where it overlaps with inflectional morphology in the use of bound morphemes) In linguistics (particularly morphology and lexicology), word formation refers to the ways in which new words are formed on the basis of other words or morphemes. This is also known as *derivational morphology*.
