occupations, typically sent with a job application

# The 3 main CV styles

There are a few different CV styles and formats to suit professionals at different stages of their careers. The choice often depends on your background and experience. The three most common formats that candidates and employers are most familiar with are chronological, functional and combination CVs:

# **Chronological CV:**

A chronological CV is the most popular style. It includes a candidate profile and summary of career progress in reverse chronological order. The career section lists roles, responsibilities and achievements in previous jobs with educational, professional qualifications and interests following.A chronological format is appropriate if you have years of experience working in a sector and have made good career progression there.

# **Functional CV:**

A functional CV, sometimes called a skills-based CV, highlights your skills and qualifications rather than your career history and



experience. This style is more suitable for recent graduates who lack experience or professionals who have career gaps. It often suits candidates who wish to make a career change.

Combination or hybrid CV:

A combination, or hybrid, CV combines chronological and functional styles. This format enables you to present a balance of career experience and relevant skills. It suits candidates who have good career progression and a range of achievements.

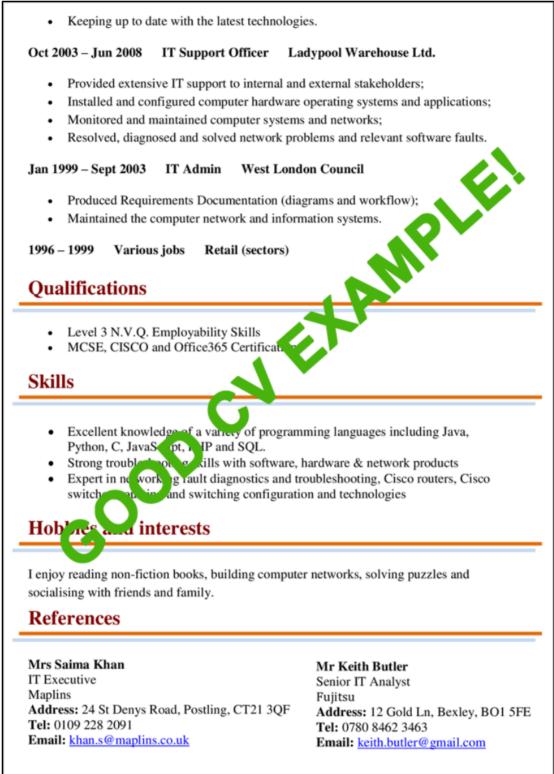
