Regular and irregular plural forms

Regular plural forms

We form the plural of most nouns by adding "s" to the singular.

For example:

- Cat: cats. - Dog: dogs. - Change: changes. - Day: days.

But: we form the plural of nouns ending in "ch", "o", "sh", "s" or "x" by adding "es".

For example:

Tomato: tomatoes.
 Bus: buses.
 Brush: brushes.
 Box: boxes.
 Church: churches
 Tax: taxes.

Irregular plural forms

 \diamond Nouns ending in a consonant + y change the "y" to "ies".

For example:

Baby: babiesCountry: countries.Fly: flies.Lady: ladies.

Some nouns ending in "o" add "s".

For example:

Kilo: kilos.Piano: pianos.Photo: photos.Radio: radios.

Some nouns ending in "f" or "fe" change the "f" or "fe" to "ves".

For example:

Half: halves.- Wife: wives.- Life: lives.- Shelf: shelves.

❖ A few nouns form their plurals by a vowel change.

For	exam	nle:

Foot: feet.Man: men.Tooth: teeth.Woman: women.

- The plural of child is children.
- Some nouns do not change at all in the plural.

For example:

- Aircraft, deer, sheep, fish.
