2-Size

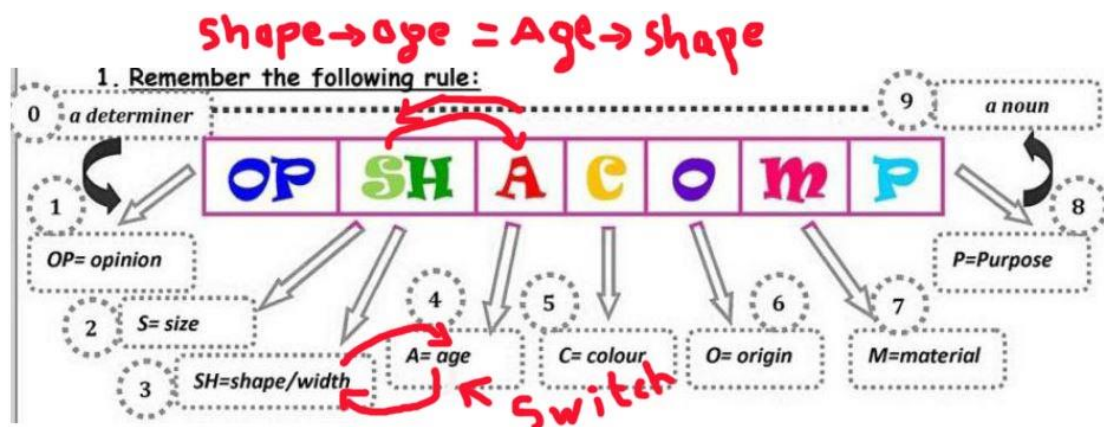
